Abstract: This paper raises some methodological issues concerning the edition of fragments from indirect sources, at the same time that it analyses and evaluates the textual variants of Menander's Carchedonius fr. 2, by studying: 1) how the passage appears in the manuscripts of the three indirect sources that transmit it; 2) how it has been edited over time in the different editions of both the sources and of Menander himself; and 3) the rela-

tionships between the sources, and the importance of those relationships for the reconstruction of the text. Finally, a proposal for the editing of the text is put forward.
